Chapter 387.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Joseph S. M. Basil and Parlett, for lumber and materials furnished for use of the House of Delegates.

Draw warrant.

Effective.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the comptroller of the treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer of the state, payable to the order of Jos. S. M. Basil and Parlett, for the sum of two hundred and eight dollars and sixty-seven cents, being the amount due them for lumber and materials furnished for use of the house of delegates. Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take

effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 388.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the German Orphan Asylum of Baltimore.

Appropriation to German Or-phan Asylum.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of twelve hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the use and benefit of the German Orphan Asylum of Baltimore city, and that said appropriation shall continue for two consecutive years.
