

**Chapter 391.**

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money to the Boys Home Society of Baltimore city.

Appropriation  
to Boys' Home.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated to the Boys Home Society for each of the years eighteen hundred and eighty-five and eighteen hundred and eighty-six; and the comptroller is directed and authorized to draw his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of the Boys Home Society for the above amount in each of the years mentioned, payable on the first day of July.

**Chapter 392.**

AN ACT to amend the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter seventy, relating to the Inner Harbor of Cambridge, by adding a section thereto.

Section added.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter seventy, entitled "An act to define and preserve the inner harbor of Cambridge and Cambridge creek, in Dorchester county," be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of a section, to read as follows, to wit:

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That if at any time any proprietor of any lands bordering upon said creek shall desire to make improvements in the waters of said creek in front of his property, and without and beyond the harbor line, he shall give notice of such intention by advertisement published at least once a week for three successive weeks in some newspaper published in said town of his intention to apply to the commissioners of Cambridge for a building permit to improve his water front, and shall at the same time
