

file his application with said commissioners, in which he shall specifically and minutely describe his proposed improvement, and upon the expiration of such notice the said commissioners shall take up such application, and hear and determine the reasons for or against granting the building permit asked for, and have full power and authority to grant the same in whole or in part, or totally reject the same, as to them may seem just and right, having regard to the public interests to be affected, as well as the interest of the particular applicant; and all the expenses connected with such application shall be defrayed by the party desiring the permit, and in no case shall devolve upon the said corporation. Power to grant

### Chapter 393.

AN ACT to authorize the county commissioners of Charles county to pay to Henry Gardiner a sum of money erroneously paid by him for taxes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the county commissioners of Charles county be and they are hereby authorized to pay to Henry Gardiner the sum of one hundred and ninety-five dollars and forty-eight cents, if in their judgment said amount has been erroneously paid by him for taxes for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, eighteen hundred and eighty, eighteen hundred and eighty-one and eighteen hundred and eighty-two. Pay sum erroneously paid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
