

Chapter 405.

AN ACT to pay the claim of M. N. Packard and Brothers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller of the treasury is hereby directed to draw his warrant, in favor of M. N. Packard and Brothers of Baltimore city, for the sum of thirty dollars, being a balance due for the slaughter of cows on January first, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, under the pleuro pneumonia act, eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter four hundred and thirty-nine.

Draw warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 406.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the Little Sisters of the Poor of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller of the treasury of the State of Maryland be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the treasurer of the state for the sum of one thousand dollars during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, and one thousand dollars during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-six, in favor of the Sister Superior of the Little Sisters of the Poor of the city of Baltimore, to be used to maintain the aged and helpless persons under their charge.
