

Chapter 410.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and thirty-six of the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Fish," and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section eighty-seven of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot county," sub-title "Fish," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

Not lawful.

Proviso.

SEC. 87. *And be it enacted,* That it shall not be lawful for any one to take or catch fish in the waters of Talbot county with seines having meshes of a size less than five inches around the square, or to land any seine upon the shores of any owner or occupant of land without the consent of such owner or occupant, nor shall it be lawful for any one, except bonafide residents of said county, to take or catch crabs, from any of such waters, of a greater depth than three feet; provided that this act shall not be construed as applying to the Choptank river, except all the creeks and tributaries of said river lying within Talbot county.

Chapter 411.

AN ACT authorizing the county commissioners of Talbot county to enlarge, extend, modify or add to the court house in Talbot county, and to levy a sum of money for the cost thereof.

Change, extend &c., the court house at Easton

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland* That the county commissioners for Talbot county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to change, modify, extend or add to the court house building in the said county at Easton, and to levy the amount of cost thereof upon the taxable property of said county, to be made at the regular
