

Chapter 413.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the county commissioners of Garrett county to pay the premium allowed on fox and wild-cat scalps taken in the years eighteen hundred and seventy-four and eighteen hundred and seventy-five and eighteen hundred and seventy-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Garrett county are hereby authorized and empowered to pay the holders of certificates for the destruction of fox and wild-cats in said county for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-four, eighteen hundred and seventy-five and eighteen hundred and seventy-six, the amount now allowed by law, and the said county commissioners are hereby authorized to levy, at their next June levy, upon the taxable property of said county a sum sufficient to pay the same.

Pay for destroying foxes and wild cats.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 414.

AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of Dublin district, number four, in Somerset county, to determine by ballot whether intoxicating liquors shall be sold in said district or license granted for the sale of the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the question of whether or not any person or persons, or any house, may be licensed in Dublin district, number four, of Somerset county, in the State of Maryland, by whom or in which spirituous or fermented liquors may be sold, shall be submitted to the voters of said election district on the
