## Chapter 422.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to reimburse M. Nelson Whiteford, late collector of taxes in the fifth election district of Harford county, for taxes erroneously paid into the treasury of this state.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the comptroller of this state be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer of this state, to pay M. Nelson Whiteford, of Harford county, the sum of fifty-seven dollars and twenty-eight cents, being the amount overpaid by said M. Nelson Whiteford into the treasury as collector of state taxes for the fifth election district of Harford county, as certified by the comptroller of this state.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## Chapter 423.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-six of article fiftysix of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Licenses," sub-title "Hawkers and Pedlars," so far as the same relates to Anne Arundel county, and to re-enact the same with amendments, so as to read as follows.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section twenty-six of article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Licenses," sub-title "Hawkers and Pedlars," be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as the same relates to Anne Arundel county, and re-enacted so as to read as follows.
