quired by the commissioners aforesaid, and he shall furnish the statement so made to the said commissioners at least ten days before the day upon which they shall determine and order the annual levy for the oath. county; and that it thereupon shall be the duty of said commissioners to place on the said levy, for the use and benefit of said clerk, such an amount of moneys as he shall be entitled to according to his statement furnished as aforesaid.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 52.

AN ACT to repeal section one of chapter ninety-six of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act for the protection of partridges and rabbits, and to permit the shooting of ducks and other wild fowl from the shore over decoys; also to pay a bounty upon the heads of large hawks and owls in Kent county," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one of chapter ninety-six of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act for the protection of partridges and rabbits, and to permit the shooting of ducks and other wild fowl from the shore over decoys; also to pay a bounty upon the heads of large hawks and owls in Kent county," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and

1. It shall not be lawful to shoot or trap any partridges or rabbits in Kent county between the fifteenth when unlawful day of January and the twenty-fifth day of October ridges, etc. next succeeding, except that they may be trapped and preserved for stocking or breeding purposes.
