Chapter 438.

AN ACT to pay William Stroudhoff fifty dollars for repairs to Canton Hay Scales.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller of the treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer of the state in favor of William Stroudhoff, or order, for the sum of fifty dollars, the same being for repairs of Canton hay scales, said amount having been passed by the legislature of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and omitted in the general appropriation bill when the same was engrossed.

Chapter 439.

AN ACT directing and authorizing the County Commissioners of Howard county to repay to Catherine E. Heckrott a sum of money for taxes overpaid in that county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the county commissioners of Howard county be and they are hereby directed and authorized to repay to Catherine E. Heckrott the sum of eleven dollars and sixty cents, being the amount over-
