Chapter 5.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a sum of money to William W. Moore, of Montgomery county, Maryland, for cattle destroyed by order of the Governor, under chapter four hundred and thirty-nine, act of eighteen hundred and eighty, Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Pleuro Pneumonia."

Draw warrant.

Full compensation.

Effective.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the State be and he is hereby directed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of the State for the sum of three hundred and sixty dollars (\$360.00), in full compensation to him, the said William W. Moore, for cattle destroyed and loss sustained by him; said healthy and diseased cattle being slaughtered by order of the Governor, under chapter four hundred and thirty-nine, laws of eighteen hundred and eighty.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
