Sanction to bequests.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the general assembly of Maryland to the bequests of Eueline Irving, late of Baltimore county, to the Home for Aged Methodists, on Fulton street, in Baltimore city; to the Maryland Bible Depository, on North Charles street, Baltimore city, and to the trustees of the Govanstown Methodist Episcopal Church, be and the same is hereby given, upon the death of the said Sarah B. Randall, now Chesney.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

### Chapter 452.

AN ACT to establish voting precincts in the fourth election district of Kent county.

Election district divided.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the fourth election district of Kent county shall be and is hereby divided into two voting precincts, in the manner hereinafter provided.

Metes and bounds.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the fourth election district of Kent county be divided into two election precincts, with the following metes and bounds, that is to say: Beginning at the mouth of Radcliffe creek, and running thence with said creek and the run or stream from the mill-pond of the Chestertown Straw-Board Company, to where the said run or stream intersects the centre of the public road leading from Chestertown to Fairlee, at or near the said mills; thence by and with the aforesaid public road to Harrisburg to Fannell's branch, to school-house number four, to where the said road intersects the stream or run, which constitutes a part of the division line between the fourth and fifth election districts, and all that part of said Chestertown district number four, lying north and east of said division line as above in-

First precinct.
