

licated, shall be known as "Precinct Number One," and the voting place shall be the court-house in Chestertown; and all that part of said Chestertown district number four, lying south and west of the aforesaid division line, shall be known as "Precinct Number Two," and the voting place shall be Pomona.

Second precinct

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the officers of registration in the said fourth election district, at the first sitting of the said officers of registration prior to the next general election, to designate on the registration books of the said district the precinct in which each of the qualified registered voters resides, and shall prepare separate lists of voters for the judges of election, according to the sub-division of said district into precincts, as hereinbefore provided, designating the election precincts of the district in which the voters are or shall be respectively entitled to vote, and deliver the same according to law.

Duty of registration officer.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the commissioners of Kent county to appoint three persons for each of said precincts, residents thereof, to act as judges of elections for said precincts, and who shall perform the duties of their office in the manner required by the election laws of the state of Maryland, and such judges shall make their returns in the same manner as if the said precincts were districts, and in accordance with the laws applicable to judges of election for districts, and they shall receive the same compensation as other judges of election in said county.

Duty of commissioner.

Returns—how made.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and that all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed.
