

license for the next three successive gunning days, and for the said period of three gunning days the said person or persons, craft and gunning outfit, shall be considered to be without license, and in case of any violation of this section the penalty shall be the same as is imposed upon persons and crafts gunning without license, and the said prohibition shall not be relieved or stayed by an appeal. Penalty.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect and be in operation from the date of its passage. Effective.

### Chapter 460.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay A. Hoen & Co. for printing the report of the commissioners appointed under joint resolution number seven of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and eighty-two to examine the condition of the oyster beds of the state.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of one thousand and eighty-five dollars and seventy cents, payable out of any money to the credit of the oyster funds in the treasury, be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay A. Hoen & Co. for the printing of the report of the commissioners appointed under joint resolution number seven of the general assembly of eighteen hundred and eighty-two to examine and report to the legislature the condition of the oyster beds of the state, and the comptroller of the state treasury is directed to draw his warrant on the treasurer, payable to the order of said A. Hoen & Co., for the said sum of one thousand and eighty-five dollars and seventy cents to pay the same. Appropriation to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
