Chapter 489.

AN ACT to pay the estate of John Murphy, late of Baltimore city, deceased, a sum of money for goods furnished the state tobacco warehouses.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller of the treasury be and he is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the treasurer to pay the estate of John Murphy, late of Baltimore city, deceased, the sum of one hundred dollars for goods furnished tobacco warehouses number one and two. Issue warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 490.

AN ACT to amend the Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, article three, sub-title "Treasurer and Collector," by repealing and re-enacting section nine of the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter one hundred and seventy-nine, so as to read as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section nine of article three of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, chapter one hundred and seventy-nine, sub-title "Treasurer and Collector," passed at January session, eighteen hundred Repealed and re-enacted.
