

and seventy-six, be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That the annual tax levy made by the county commissioners shall be due and payable on the first day of the month next following that on which it shall have been made, and from all taxes so levied which shall be paid prior to the first day of June a discount of four per cent. shall be deducted from the amount thereof; on all taxes paid during the month of June a discount of three and a-half per cent. shall be made; on all taxes paid during the month of July, a discount of three per cent. shall be made; on all taxes paid during the month of August, a discount of two and a-half per cent shall be made; on all taxes paid during the month of September, a discount of two per cent. shall be made; on all taxes paid during the month of October, a discount of one and a-half per cent. shall be made; on all taxes paid during the month of November, a discount of one per cent. shall be made; and upon all bills paid during the month of December, the amount thereof, without discount or interest, shall be required, but upon all bills remaining unpaid after that time, interest shall be charged and collected from the date when they shall have been due and payable.
