

Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Patuxent," regulating the right of fishing in the Patuxent river and its tributaries, as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and nineteen, and to re enact the same, adding thereto the following sub-section," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Unlawful to haul.

SUB-SEC. 3. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons, except bona fide residents of St. Mary's, Anne Arundel, Charles, Calvert and Prince George's counties to haul in the waters of the Patuxent river, between Sheridan's Point and Point Patience, any seine of greater length than sixty fathoms at any time between the first day of June and the first day of October following.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 504.

AN ACT to repeal section four, chapter seven, of the acts passed at the special session of the General Assembly of Maryland, held at Frederick, April twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, entitled "An act to amend the eighty-third article of the Code of Public General Laws by exempting a certain amount of property from execution," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section four, chapter seven, of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the special session held at Frederick, April twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows :

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That all wearing apparel, mechanical text-books and books of professional
