

men, tools of mechanics, and all tools or other mechanical instruments or appliances moved or worked by the hand or foot, necessary to the practice of any trade or profession, and used in the practice thereof, shall be exempt from execution, in addition to the property hereinbefore exempted; but this section shall not apply to any books, tools, mechanical instruments or appliances kept for sale or barter.

Chapter 505.

AN ACT to permit the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to lay out and open public roads in the Thirteenth Election District of said county, south of the Washington road, within two miles of Baltimore city.

WHEREAS, by chapter ninety-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, it was provided that street commissioners should be appointed to lay off all that part of Baltimore county, within two miles of the limits of the city of Baltimore, into streets, avenues, &c.; and, whereas, that part of said territory south and east of the Washington road has not been so laid off, and the public convenience demands that certain roads should be laid out and constructed immediately for public use within said limits.

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to lay out and construct, under the provisions of the present road laws of Baltimore county, such roads or avenues within that part of the Thirteenth Election District of Baltimore county lying within two miles of the present limits of the city of Baltimore, and south and east of the Washington road as may be demanded for the convenience of the people of said district.
