Chapter 6.

AN ACT to repeal section eight of an act to incorporate a company to establish a Public Cemetery at Westminister in Carroll county, and to revive and connect therewith the charter of the "Westminister General Meeting House and Burying Ground," passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter one hundred and sixty-one, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section eight of an act to incorporate a company to establish a public cemetery at Westminister in Carroll county, and to revive and connect therewith the charter of the "Westminister re-enacted. General Meeting House and Burying Ground," passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and sixtyfour, chapter one hundred and sixty-one, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 8. Be it further enacted, That the charter granted to the trustees of the Westminister General Meeting House in Carroll county, as aforesaid, be and the same is hereby revived, and that all the rights, franchises, privileges and immunities conferred by the said charter on said trustees be and are hereby vested Charter revived in the said Westminister Cemetery Company, and the president and managers thereof, with power to do all acts necessary to protect and manage said meeting house and burying ground as fully as the trustees elected under said charter could have done; and the said president and managers shall also have power and authority to lay off burial lots, roads and walks in said burying grounds, and remove such graves as agers. they may deem necessary to be removed for such purposes; and shall also have full power and authority to exercise such general management and control of said burying ground as they now have over the remaining part of the cemetery grounds under the provisions of this act; provided that the said president and managers shall set apart and maintain a portion of the cemetery grounds for the purpose of free burial, under such rules and regulations as they may deem proper;
