

To report. to said Board all cases of infectious or contagious disease among live stock which may come to their knowledge, and a failure so to do for forty-eight hours after he or they shall come into such knowledge, shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined a sum not exceeding fifty dollars for each offence.

Offence. SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be unlawful for any person to inoculate any animal in this State with the virus of any infectious or contagious disease incident to animals without the consent of said Live Stock Sanitary Board, and that any persons convicted of this offence shall be fined a sum not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars, in the discretion of the Court.

Fees. SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That for the performances of the duties imposed on them by the act of which this is supplemental, all Constables, Sheriffs or Deputy Sheriffs or other State officers shall be paid as for the performance of similar duties under existing laws.

State's Att'ys. SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of all State's Attorneys to prosecute all persons accused of violating this act, or the act to which this is a supplement.

Rules and regulations. Appraisement. SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That all rules and regulations formulated and issued by said Board in pursuance of the powers hereby conferred on them shall have the force of law, and all violations thereof shall be punished as provided in the original act of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, chapter one hundred and fifty-seven, and all appraisements of animals to be slaughtered, or of buildings to be destroyed, shall be approved by said Board before such animals are slaughtered or such buildings destroyed; and said Board shall have the discretion to have such appraised animals destroyed or quarantined.
