of the Circuit Court of said county a license permitting the person named therein to sell or ship the same beyond the limits of said county for one year from the day on which said license is issued, and that the person named therein or party procuring such license shall pay to said Clerk for such license the sum of one hundred dollars, and fifty cents to the Clerk for his fee for issuing such license; any person violating the provision of this section by selling or shipping game for sale shall be fined the sum of five dollars for every partridge, woodcock or rabbit sold or shipped.

To sell else-

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the possession by any person within the county of any of the birds or rabbits mentioned in the preceding section of this act at any time in which the shooting or trapping of the same is prohibited by said preceding section, or the possession by any express or transportation company of any partridge, woodcock or rabbit at any time shall be prima facie evidence of violation of this act.

Evidence.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That any person or persons found trespassing upon any private property in this county which shall have been posted or advertised, shall be liable to be arrested by any Constable of the county, and shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace of said county shall be fined the sum of five dollars, and on failure to pay said fine shall be confined in the county jail for a term of ten days.

Trespass.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That the fines which may be collected by any Justice of the Peace of said county, under the provisions of this act, and the money paid to said Clerk of the Circuit Court for licenses, under the provisions of this act, shall be paid by the said Justice of the Peace and the Clerk to the County Commissioners of said county, to be by them placed to the credit of the school funds for said county.
