CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to extend the time of Elijah B. Prettyman, late Clerk of the Circuit Court for Montgomery county, to complete the business of his said office, unfinished at the close of his official term of office.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Elijah B. Prettyman, late Clerk of the Circuit Court for Montgomery county shall be allowed further time until the first day of December, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, to complete the business of his said office, unfinished at the close of his term of office on the first day of December, eighteen hundred and eighty-five, and shall have during that period a right, on receipting therefor to his successor, to all needful papers, in order to enable him to complete and finish his business.
