election districts of the county aforesaid to arrest any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this act, and take them before the nearest Justice of the Peace, to be dealt with as this act has heretofore directed.

Arrests.

SEC. 10. Be it further enacted, That it shall be lawful to shoot ducks or other wild fowl from the shore over decoys in said county.

Ducks.

SEC. 11. Be it further enacted, That any person killing any large hawks or owls in said county shall be entitled to a bounty of fifty cents for each and every hawk or owl killed.

Bounty for hawks or owls.

SEC. 12. Be it further enacted, That to obtain such bounty it shall be necessary for the person killing hawks or owls to produce the heads of the same before some Justice of the Peace of said county, and make affidavit that the hawks or owls were killed within the limits of said county, and thereupon the said Justice shall give a certificate of the production of the said head or heads before him and of the said affidavit, and it shall be the duty of the said Justice to burn or otherwise destroy the said head or heads, so as to prevent a second allowance for the same.

Must produce

SEC. 13. Be it further enacted, That upon the production of the said Justice's certificate the Commissioners of said county shall levy for the use of the party holding and producing the same a sum sufficient to pay the aforesaid bounty.

Expense.

Sec. 14. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
