

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT to empower the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county to levy a sum of money for the building of a school-house for colored children in Medley's Neck, in St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That County Commissioners of St. Mary's county be and they are hereby empowered and directed to levy for the building of a school-house for colored children in Medley's Neck, in St. Mary's county, such a sum of money as in the opinion of the said Commissioners may be sufficient for the purpose hereinbefore specified.

Levy for the building of a School-house.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
