SEC. 204. There shall be the following number of Justices of the Peace and Constables for Washington county, to be appointed for the election districts in said county, as follows: Number one, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number two, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for numbers three, seventeen, twenty-one and twenty-two constituting the town of Hagerstown and vicinity, eight Justices of the Peace and six Constables; number four, two Justices of the Peace and two constables; number five, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number six, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number seven, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number eight, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number nine, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number ten, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number eleven, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number twelve, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number thirteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number fourteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number fifteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number sixteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number eighteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number twenty, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number twenty-three, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables.
