dred and sixteen of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

Sec. 204. There shall be the following number of Justices of the Peace and Constables for Washington county, to be appointed for the election districts in said county, as follows: Number one, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number two, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for numbers three, seventeen, twenty-one and twenty-two constituting the town of Hagerstown and vicinity, eight Justices of the Peace and six Constables; number four, two Justices of the Peace and two constables; number five, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number six, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables: number seven, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number eight, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables: number nine. two Justices of the Peace and two Constables: number ten, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables: number eleven, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables: number twelve, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number thirteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number fourteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number fifteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables: number sixteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number eighteen, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number twenty, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; number twenty-three, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables.

Appointment of Justices of the Peace for Washington county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
