title "Chancery," sub-title "Jurisdiction," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional sections:

Sec. —. In cases where proceedings have been or shall be instituted for the renewal of a lease containing a covenant for renewal, the Court may pass a decree for the renewal of such lease, which shall be binding upon all persons who shall have become parties to such proceedings by summons or appearance, or who shall have been proceeded against by ·publication, as provided by section ninetyeight of this article; and such decree shall be sufficient to renew the title of all persons interested under such lease according to their respective interests and estates thereunder for such additional term, under such rent and upon such covenants, conditions and stipulations as were provided in such lease.

Renewal of lease.

SEC. —. Every renewal decree passed under the provisions of the preceding section shall be recorded among the land records of the county or city where the land affected by such decree may lie.
