to distribute the report of his office in manner following: four copies to each of the Members of the General Assembly of Maryland; ten copies to the State Library; two copies to each of the public libraries of the State; one copy to each newspaper published in the State; one copy to each regularly organized Trade Association; one copy to each regularly organized Mercantile or Commercial Association; one copy to each of the several Labor Bureaus of the several States; and one copy to each department of the National Government; the residue of the copies printed to be distributed according to the list of applications on record in the office of said Bureau.

Distribution.

SEC. 5. Be it enacted, That for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this act, the sum of two thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated; the same to be paid by the Treasurer of the State upon the warrant of the Comptroller of the State, in such sums and at such times as shall be directed by the Governor by his order in writing.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 157.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Pinkney A. Scaggs, late Sheriff of Prince George's county, for fees erroneously paid into the State Treasury.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State in favor of Pinkney A. Scaggs,
