CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to pay Findlay Roberts & Co. a sum of money due them from State Tobacco Warehouse Number Two, and State Tobacco Warehouse Number Four, and also to A. W. Smith & Co., for money due them from Tobacco Warehouse Number One.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer to pay Findlay Roberts & Co. sixty-seven dollars and seventy-five cents, being for nails furnished State Tobacco Warehouse Number Two; also twenty-nine dollars, being for nails furnished State Tobacco Warehouse Number Four; and also to A. W. Smith & Co. one hundred and twenty-seven dollars and twenty-five cents, being for nails furnished State Tobacco Warehouse Number One.
