

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section three of chapter four hundred and seventy-two of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled an act for the better protection of birds and game in Wicomico county, as repealed and re-enacted by chapter ninety-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an act to repeal, amend and re-enact section three of chapter four hundred and seventy-two, passed at the January session, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty, for the better protection of birds and game in Wicomico county, with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section three of chapter four hundred and seventy-two of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled an act for the better protection of birds and game in Wicomico county, as repealed, amended and re-enacted by chapter ninety-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an act to repeal, amend and re-enact section three of chapter four hundred and seventy-two, passed at the January session, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled an act for the better protection of birds and game in Wicomico county, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows :

Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons in Wicomico county to shoot, kill, take, trap or in any manner destroy or catch in said county any of the birds or game within the different periods of time mentioned and specified in this section—that is to say, woodcock between the first day of February
