and the fifteenth day of June; plover or sandpipers, partridges and quail between the first day of January and the first day of November; wood or summer ducks between the first day of January and the tenth day of September; squirrels between the fifteenth day of February and the first day of September; rabbits between the fifteenth day of February and the first day of November; minks, otters and musk-rats between the fifteenth day of March and the fifteenth day of December; each and every person violating the provisions of this section shall be fined ten dollars for each and every woodcock, plover or sand-piper, partridge, quail, duck, squirrel, rabbit, mink, otter or musk-rat so killed, taken, trapped, shot or destroyed within said specified time, and possession of any of the withinnamed birds or game, dead or alive, within any of the specified times by any person or persons in said county shall be deemed unlawful, and be punishable by a fine of ten dollars for each and every bird or animal named in this act.
