

Election no-
tice.

SECTION 103. If at any time an election shall not be held for Commissioners at the time named in this article, an election may be held at any time after ten days' notice thereof shall have been given by the Commissioners, or a majority of them; and if the said Commissioners shall fail or neglect to give such notice within the period of sixty days after the time named in this article for holding such elections, an election may be held at any time after ten days' notice thereof shall have been given by five of the qualified voters of said town.

CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT to add two additional sections to article forty-four of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Hospital-Maryland," as the same was amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-one, and by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and forty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sections, to be arranged and numbered as sections fourteen and fifteen, respectively, be and the same are hereby added to article forty-four of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Hospital-Maryland," as the same was amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-one, and by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and forty-one, viz:

SEC. 14. The said Board of Managers shall erect and maintain in safe and proper repair a substantial and sufficient fence and enclosure
