Board, its officers and agents, and the discharge of its and their respective duties in executing and carrying into effect the objects and purposes of this act.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That if at any time hereafter the said Board of Governors may deem it advisable, in the interest of said corporation, to increase the number of members of said Board, as now constituted, they are at liberty so to do, and for such purpose they are hereby authorized and empowered, from time to time, and at such times as they may think proper, to add to and increase the number of said Board of Governors by electing thereto some suitable person or persons as members thereof; but the whole number of members of said Board shall at no time exceed eight in number.

Limited.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly of Maryland reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this act, or any part thereof, at its pleasure.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to refund to the Consolidated Gas Company of Baltimore city, a sum of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury for State taxes for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed and required to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to the order of the Consolidated Gas Company

Re-pay taxes.
