CHAPTER 218.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Caroline county to appoint an additional Constable for the Fourth Election District of said county, to reside in Harmony Precinct.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Caroline county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to appoint an additional Constable for the Fourth Election District of Caroline county, to reside in Harmony Precinct.
