CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Caroline county to appropriate a sum of money annually, to assist the incorporated towns in said county to improve and keep in repair the road-beds of said towns.

Whereas the citizens of the several incorporated towns in Caroline county are taxed annually for county purposes; and

Preamble.

Whereas the said towns have no benefit of the said taxes in the improvements and repair of the public streets thereof; therefore,

Preamble.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Caroline county be and are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to appropriate annually, and pay over to the Town Commissioners, or a majority of them, of the several incorporated towns in said county, a sum of money in their judgment sufficient to assist in improving and repairing the road-beds of said towns.

To repair streets.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and are hereby repealed.

Repeal.

SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
