## CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of fifty dollars to pay Andrew J. Smoot, to reimburse him for money paid to the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city as tax on his commission appointing him Tobacco Inspector of Warehouse Number Two, in Baltimore city, by the Governor of the State, on the tenth day of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, he having failed to get possession of the office under a decision of the Court of Appeals.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State for the sum of fifty dollars in favor of Andrew J. Smoot, to reimburse him for money paid to the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city for tax on his commission as Tobacco Inspector of Warehouse Number Two of Baltimore city, issued to him by the Executive of the State on the tenth day of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-two.
