CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT to repeal chapter forty, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an act to incorporate the town of Westernport, Allegany county, Maryland; and chapter one hundred and twenty-seven, passed at the January session A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an act to add certain sections to the charter of the town of Westernport, in Allegany county, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly, That chapter forty of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an act to incorporate the town of Westernport, Allegany county, Maryland; and chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an act to add certain sections to the charter of the town of Westernport, in Allegany county, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the same re-enacted as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. And be it enacted, That the citizens of the town of Westernport, in Allegany county, shall be and they are hereby constituted and made a body corporate, by the name of the Commissioners of Westernport, with all the privileges of a body corporate, and to have a common seal and perpetual succession.

Corporation.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the limits of said town shall extend as follows: Beginning at the mouth of the sewer of the upper round-house of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company's shops, and running north twenty-five degrees (25°) west four hundred feet to the county road; then north twenty-one and
