

CHAPTER 244.

AN ACT to repeal sections one, two, three, four, five, six, seven and eight, of chapter one hundred and eight, of the acts of Assembly of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled 'Garrett county,' sub-title 'Birds,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections, one, two, three, four, five, six, seven and eight of chapter one hundred and eight of the acts of Assembly of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled 'Garrett county,' sub-title 'Birds,' be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Unlawful to kill, etc.

SEC. 1. It shall not be lawful for any person to shoot, kill or in any way trap or destroy in Garrett county, any blue-birds, swallows, martins, cat-birds, sparrows, wrens, whip-poor-will or any other insectivorous birds at any season of the year, under the penalty of two dollars fine for each bird so taken, killed or destroyed.

Unlawful to kill, etc.

SEC. 2. It shall not be lawful for any person to kill, destroy, snare or in any way entrap in Garrett county any pheasant, woodcock or partridge, between the first day of December and the first day of September, in each year, or to snare or in any way entrap any pheasant at any season of the year whatsoever; or to kill or destroy, snare or entrap any partridge between the first day of December and the fifteenth day of October, in each year.

SEC. 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of said section two, shall be deemed
