## CHAPTER 268.

AN ACT to repeal the act passed at the January session of the General Assembly in eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and forty-five, relating to fences in Somerset county, so far as the same relates to Lawson's and Brinkley's Districts, in said county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter four hundred and forty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same relates to Brinkley's and Lawson's Districts, in Somerset county.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 269.

AN ACT to authorize the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Montgomery county, to destroy certain registration and poll-books.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Montgomery county, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to destroy all registration and poll-books now in his custody, except those made and used in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five.
