CHAPTER 278.

AN ACT to repeal section three of article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Education of Deaf, Dumb and Blind," sub-title "Indigent Blind," as repealed and re-enacted by chapter two hundred and five of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and to repeal section five of said article, as repealed and re-enacted by chapter seventy-five of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section three of article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Education of Deaf, Dumb and Blind," sub-title "Indigent Blind," as repealed and re-enacted by chapter two hundred and five of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and section five of said article, as repealed and re-enacted by chapter seventy-five of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of the year eigh-
