CHAPTER 285.

AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of Wicomico county to determine by ballot, whether chapter eleven of the acts of the General Assembly, passed at the session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled an act regulating fences in Wicomico county, as amended by chapter sixty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled an act to repeal sections one and two of an act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter eleven, entitled an act regulating fences in Wicomico county, and to re-enact same with amendments, shall be repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the question whether or not chapter eleven of the acts of the General Assembly, passed at the session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled an act regulating fences in Wicomico county, as amended by chapter sixty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled an act to repeal sections one and two of an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter eleven, entitled an act regulating fences in Wicomico county, and to re-enact same with amendments, shall be repealed, shall be submitted to the registered and qualified voters of Wicomico county at the general election, to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, and the Sheriff of said county shall give notice of the time and pur-
