for the prompt payment of the principal and interest of the said bonds, and shall provide the mode and manner in which such payment shall be made, the said taxes to be levied and collected as other taxes in said county are levied and collected.

Vote county

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That a majority of said County Commissioners are hereby empowered to vote the stock subscribed for, by virtue of this act, at any meeting of the stockholders of the Delaware and Chesapeake Railway, in such manner and subject to such resolutions and conditions as the private stockholders in said company are or may be authorized to vote their individual stock.

Effective.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of Boards of School Commissioners for Prince George's, Charles, Caroline and Montgomery counties.

Repealed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section six of article twenty-seven of the Code of Public General Laws, be and the same is hereby repealed, as far as it relates to Prince George's, Charles, Caroline and Montgomery counties, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

SEC. 2. The Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, shall, at every regular session of the General Assembly, beginning with the session of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, appoint three persons in each of the following counties, namely, Prince George's,
