

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT to provide for the restoration of certain Records in the office of the Register of Wills for Anne Arundel county.

Preamble

WHEREAS, There are in the office of the Register of Wills for Anne Arundel county, a docket of administrators and executors from eighteen hundred and seventy-two, and a will-book (R. I. D., No. 1), which are now in a dilapidated condition and should be copied in new and substantial books; and there are also several books containing administrators' and executors' accounts from seventeen hundred and seventy-seven, of which there is no general index, but which should be indexed so as to make it convenient to search for such accounts.

To renew certain records.

Indexes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Register of Wills for Anne Arundel county be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to make copies of said docket of administrators and executors from eighteen hundred and seventy-two, and of will-book "R. I. D. No. 1," and make indexes of the same; and also to make a general index of the administrators' and executors' accounts from seventeen hundred and seventy-seven.

Expenses of same.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the expenses of making said copies and indexes shall be paid by Anne Arundel county, and the County Commissioners for said county, are hereby authorized and required to levy such sum or sums of money as may be necessary to pay the Register of Wills the expenses of making said copies and indexes, which said expenses shall be at the rate now allowed by law for such services to Registers of Wills, and the costs of the books into which said copies and indexes shall be made.
