said vessels in good order, and the Treasurer of the State, upon requisition of said Board and the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby required and directed to pay the sum or sums necessary to carry out the provisions of this act.

Keep con-
stantly on
hand.

SEC. 28. *And be it enacted*, That the Deputy Commanders of the steamers be and they are hereby required to keep their vessels constantly on duty when circumstances will permit, and that every locality where a violation of the law is likely to occur, shall be visited as often as the duties of the force and condition of the vessels will allow, and that every three months a report shall be made to the Board of Public Works of all official action taken under the law.

Sloops con-
fined to their
own districts.

SEC. 29. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the Deputy Commanders of the sloops to confine themselves ordinarily to their several districts, but it shall be their duty also to enforce any of the provisions of this act in any water adjacent to their district, when a violation of the same shall to come to their knowledge.

Bonds.

SEC. 30. *And be it enacted*, That the Commanding Officer and the Deputy Commanders of said force, shall, before entering upon the discharge of their duties, take before one of the Judges of the Circuit Courts the oath prescribed by the Constitution, and the Commanding Officer of said force shall enter into bond to the State of Maryland in the sum of ten thousand dollars, and each Deputy Commander in the sum of three thousand dollars, to be approved by said Judges, for the faithful performance of their duties as prescribed in this act, the said bond or bonds to be filed with the Comptroller.

SEC. 31. *And be it enacted*, That the salary of the Commander shall be fifteen hundred dollars, and the salary of Deputy Commanders
