

Numbers.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That every licensed tonger under the provisions of this act shall paint the number of his license in black figures on a white ground upon the outside of the boat to be used by him in catching oysters; said figures to be not less than four inches in length and of proportionate width, and to be painted near the gunwale on each side of the boat; and no number other than that specified in the license shall be exposed to view in said canoe or boat; any person or persons violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this section, shall upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than ten dollars.

Seizure.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That upon information given under oath to any Judge of the Circuit Court, or any Justice of the Peace of St. Mary's county, of any violations of any of the provisions of this act in said county, he shall issue a warrant for the arrest of the offender, and the seizure of the boat, vessel and equipments, which warrants shall be directed to the Sheriff or any Constable of said county, or to any licensed tongman of said county under this act, or to any officer of the State Fishery Force; and said person or persons when arrested shall be taken before said Judge or Justice of the Peace to answer said warrant, and the boat, vessel and equipments shall be held as security for the payment of the fine imposed and costs of prosecution for violating the provisions of this act, which fine and costs of prosecution shall be a lien upon the boat and equipments so seized and taken for violation of this act; and if said fine and costs be not paid within ten days after conviction, said boat and equipments shall be sold to satisfy the amount of said fine and costs, after due notice given by said Sheriff or Constable seizing the same.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That any person or persons convicted before any Justice of the
