

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the members of the said Baltimore Club of Baltimore city, be and they are hereby empowered to elect such number of Trustees, Managers, Directors or Governors, for the management of the property and concerns of said corporation, and in such manner, at such times, and for such term or terms of office as the said club, by its by-laws, does now or shall hereafter prescribe.

Directors.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall require a nine-tenths vote of all the members of the said club, exclusive of non-resident members, to repeal or amend the by-laws forbidding gaming, heretofore adopted by said club, and which reads as follows, to wit: "No stakes of any kind, either directly or indirectly, shall be allowed on any event taking place in the club house."

Gaming.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That it shall require a nine-tenths vote of all the members of the said club, exclusive of non-resident members, to repeal or amend the by-laws forbidding treating, heretofore adopted by said club, which reads as follows, to wit: "There shall be no treating in the club house between members, except in such manner as the Board of Governors may provide."

Treating.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
