

Object. adoption and carrying out the rules and discipline of the religious Society of Friends, who now hold their Yearly Meeting on Eutaw street, in the city of Baltimore, and for the carrying out such religious, educational and charitable work as that in which the said Society of Friends has been or may hereafter be engaged.

Rules and discipline. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the rules and discipline of said Society of Friends, as laid down in its last Book of Discipline, adopted by said Yearly Meeting in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, shall be the rules and discipline of the corporation hereby created, and the same may be altered and changed in such manner as has been or may hereafter be adopted by said Yearly Meeting.

Effective. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 329.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact chapter eighty-nine of the acts passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an act to change a portion of the dividing line between the Fifth and Sixth Election Districts of Garrett county.

Dividing line. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter eighty-nine of the acts passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at January session eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an act to change a portion of the dividing line between the Fifth and Sixth Election Districts of Garrett county, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-
