

Expenses.

shall be established and placed by the County Commissioners according to what is known as the Decimal Plan; provided, that the expense of each number-plate required to be furnished as aforesaid shall not exceed the sum of twenty-five cents, the expense to be paid by the owner or occupier of the premises; and any owner or occupier shall have the privilege of replacing any number-plate so furnished with another, provided the same number be retained.

Fines.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That any person who shall refuse to permit the number-plate so placed on his premises by the County Commissioners, to be and remain thereon, or who shall alter, deface or remove such number-plate except as therein provided, shall forfeit and pay a fine of ten dollars for every such offence, to be recovered as other fines are directed to be recovered by law.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
