CHAPTER 346.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for each of the years eighteen hundred and eighty-seven and eighteen hundred and eighty-eight to the Hebrew Hospital and Asylum Association of Baltimore city.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for each of the years eighteen hundred and eighty-seven and eighteen hundred and eighty-eight is hereby appropriated to the Hebrew Hospital and Asylum Association of Baltimore city, and the Comptroller of the Treasury is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State in favor of the Hebrew Hospital and Asylum Association of Baltimore city for the amount of the above appropriation in each of said years.
