

determine, said sum not to be less than twenty-five cents, nor more than fifty cents per day, and to an annual allowance from said county sufficient to furnish fuel for the comfort and benefit of said prisoners.

Jailor's fee.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect on the first day of November eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.

CHAPTER 362.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the German Orphant Asylum of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the use and benefit of the German Orphant Asylum of Baltimore city, and that said appropriation shall continue for two consecutive years.

Appropriation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That said sum of fifteen hundred dollars per annum be and the same is hereby made payable by the Treasurer of the State, on the warrant of the Comptroller, to the President of the German Orphant Asylum of Baltimore city, on the first day of June, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, and on the first day of June, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight.
