

the taking of said oath; and it shall be the duty of the said Justice of the Peace to destroy such head so as to prevent a second allowance for the same.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That upon the production of such certificate, the County Commissioners of Charles county are hereby authorized and directed to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sum sufficient for the aforesaid bounty for the use of the person or persons producing the same, and the Collectors of taxes shall collect and pay the same accordingly.

To pay.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That no Justice of the Peace shall be entitled to any fee or reward for the issuing of such certificate.

No fee.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the foregoing sections shall not be so construed as to include any fish hawk.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 378.

AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of Election District Number Three or Vienna, in Dorchester county, to determine by ballot whether the existing fence law in said election district, shall be repealed or remain in full force.
